As the year 2017 comes to an end, the Cats Angels Board of Directors would like to thank all of our supporters, contributors and volunteers for making it a good one for the cats of Nassau County. Cats Angels runs a hands-on, "no frills" rescue program that has saved the lives of thousands of abandoned, stray and outdoor cats. Our dedicated volunteers are out in all types of weather: rain, heat, and even hurricanes, all with the goal of making life better for our feline friends. With the help of First Coast No More Homeless Pets, our spay/neuter surgeries for 2017 are close to the 900 mark, and in addition their caring veterinarians take care of our wellness cats and perform dentals and special procedures, some quite extensive.



Cats Angels hosts the Nassau County Animal Expo where animal advocates join together to promote the nurturing of all animals that need our intervention, to educate the community on the importance of spay/neuter/vaccination and to help promote the adoption of rescued animals. In August Cats Angels focuses attention on Homeless Animals Month in association with the International Society for Animal Rights (ISAR). A Proclamation is received from the City of Fernandina Beach and we sponsor a Walk and Candlelight Vigil to commemorate Homeless Animals Day.

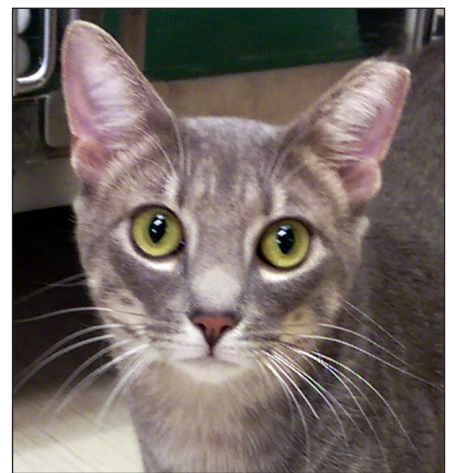
